

Objectives: Students share information about their personal aspirations and their hopes for the world. They explore the importance of one of the Olympic values in achieving these goals. Work from each school is swapped and used for the basis of a discussion exploring similarities and differences and the significance of Olympic values in different cultures.

Allow 30 minutes for completion of the worksheet. Once completed, collect and send to your partner school.</p> <p><i>Alternative approach: information about aspirations and the importance of the Olympic values could be explored in a range of different ways e.g through discursive writing, as part of a video or audio recording of a discussion or as the focus of an art project</i></p> <p><b>Please remember to include a Shared Learning Grid (available for download from our resource website) in any materials you send to your partner school.</b></p> <p>Link Ethiopia will work with your partner school to carry out a similar activity and return their responses to you.</p>	<p>Once you have received a response from your partner school, their work can be used as a basis for group discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Were their aspirations similar or different to ours? Were any of their responses surprising? Why were they surprising? Have any of your attitudes or assumptions changed?</li> <li>- How are the Olympic values significant in Ethiopia? Did the Ethiopian students focus on the same values as you? What were the differences in their responses?</li> <li>- Reconsider the Olympic values. Has our attitude about their importance changed? Are there any other values that you think should be included?</li> </ul>
